World Conference Resolution 1325 calls Community of Christ to join with others in declaring a climate emergency and for administrators at all levels to lead the church toward increased awareness and Responsible Choices through actions that support healing of the Earth.

As people of the Temple dedicated to peace, we proclaim the reconciling and restoring purposes of God revealed through Jesus the peaceful One, whose name we bear. We recommit ourselves to sacramental living that respects and reveals God's presence and reconciling activity in all creation. We proactively join with God as stewards of the Earth: 1) to reduce carbon emissions as individuals and as a faith community; 2) to consider the impact of climate change on the environment when reviewing policies and strategies; and 3) to support organizations and groups that peaceably raise awareness or act in response to the climate crisis.

- Encourage prayer and reflection on the climate crisis to deepen one's commitment to

- Challenge individuals to use their personal power to change their consumption habits and share their desires for a more sustainable world with our communities, employers, and those who represent them politically.
- Advocate. Call on Christians to engage in advocacy aimed at promoting climate-friendly
 policies and holding corporations and governments accountable for their environmental
 impact.
- Stress the importance of working with people of other faiths and secular organizations to address the climate crisis collectively. Recognize that environmental stewardship is a shared responsibility.
- Develop or identify resources in coordination with the Earth Stewardship Team and others to help leaders and individuals identify ways to reduce carbon emissions.
- Highlight the disproportionate impact of climate change on vulnerable communities, locally and globally. Advocate for policies and actions that prioritize the needs of marginalized and low-income individuals and communities.
